Beaverton Visual Arts Showcase Deadline to Enter - October 30, 2009

Visual Arts Showcase, 28th Annual

Visual artists in Oregon are invited to submit their work to Beaverton's 2010 Visual Arts Showcase to be held February 7-20, 2010, in the Beaverton City Library.

Showcase artists will be honored at an opening night gala on Saturday, February 6, 2010. Prizes will be awarded including four, \$200, first place awards and a \$500, Best of Show prize.

Showcase 2010 Entrants Calendar

Entries must be submitted by Friday, October 30th, 2009.

Notification of acceptance or non-acceptance will occur the week of December 14, 2009.

Accepted artworks must be delivered to Beaverton City Library on Friday, January 29, 2010, Noon to 3 p.m.

Artwork must be picked up at the Beaverton City Library on Sunday, February 21, 2010, Noon to 3 p.m.

Eligibility

Artists must live in Oregon.

All work must be original and have been completed within the last two years.

An accepted piece of art from a previous Showcase may not be entered again.

All artwork must be for sale.

The sales price of a submitted work may not exceed \$4,000.

No student work or work done in a class is eligible.

A total of four works may be submitted for consideration.

Fees

There is no entry fee. Selected artists will be asked to pay a \$20 hanging fee payable at the time the artwork is delivered. This fee will help offset the cost of advertising the show.

Volunteer Requirement

Artists must volunteer at least three hours during the Showcase exhibition to ensure the exhibition is open all library hours.

Sales

A 30% commission will be taken from all sales.

Agreement

Submission of artwork to Showcase 2010 constitutes an agreement to the terms set forth in this prospectus and permission to photograph artwork and/or reproduce images for the purpose of Showcase 2010 promotion. The Beaverton Arts Commission, City of Beaverton and judges reserve the right of final selection of artworks to be included in the exhibition upon the arrival of the actual pieces. Artists must sign a consignment contract pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes before their artwork can be shown.

Liability

Artworks will be insured for up to 70% of the indicated sale value while on exhibition. Insurance in transit is the responsibility of the artist.

Deadline

Friday, October 30, 2009.
